Batteries

Many supermarkets and electrical stores collect these for recycling

Christmas trees (real ones only)

- Plant a real christmas tree with roots to use again next year
- Compost at a Household Recycling Centre

Cards

- Cut up to use as gift tags next year
- Recycle in your green recycling bin

Large cardboard boxes

- Remove all packaging
- Break up and put in your green recycling bin or
- Flatten and leave next to your bin

Wrapping paper

- Save and reuse next year
- Flatten to use less space in your recycling bin
- No foil or plastic wrapping paper please

Plastic and glass bottles, jars and tubs

- Recycle in your green recycling bin
- Recycle at a Household Recycling Centre
- Recycle glass in a bank at selected supermarkets

Food

- Home compost your vegetable peelings
- Get creative with leftovers
