A49 Peterstow resurfacing and Harewood End junction improvement: Traffic Management Update

19 August to 25 August 2019

Welcome to our traffic management update for the A49 Peterstow resurfacing and Harewood End junction improvement works.

Work will continue with night time work from Monday 19 August for the remainder of the works. Work will begin at 9pm and finish at 6am, and there will be no restrictions on the A49 during the day. Unfortunately, there will be additional noise and lighting overnight that may cause some inconvenience to local residents, however please be assured that we'll do our best to mitigate these.

What have we completed so far

Week commencing 12 August 2019, resurfacing was completed along the A49 between Wellsbrook Lane and Everstone Rise (Red Lion junction). We also completed work with resetting drainage covers in line with the completed resurfacing.

Summary of the next 5 days of traffic management

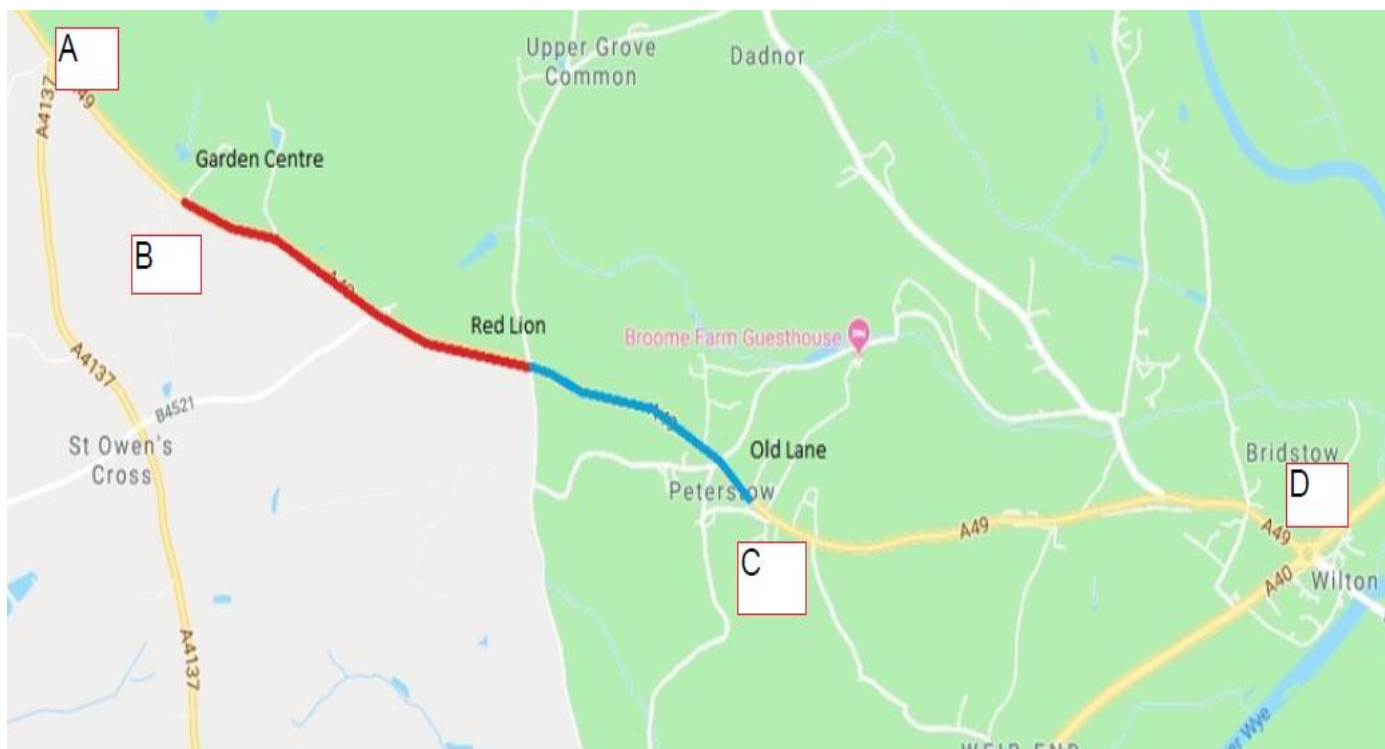
We will be completing the road markings between Old Lane and Everstone Rise (Red Lion pub junction) which is highlighted in blue on the map below. We will also be completing resurfacing and road markings between Everstone Rise (Red Lion pub junction) and Pengethley Garden Centre, which is highlighted in red on the map below.

Access will remain open for emergency vehicles and access to frontages will be maintained. We're sorry for the disruption and inconvenience; please plan and allow extra time for your journey. For further information about the traffic management, please contact: info@highwaysengland.co.uk

Road users wishing to access the A49 between A and B on the map below from Wilton Roundabout will be diverted south-west on the A40 to the junction with the A4137. Traffic will then be diverted from the A40 onto the A4137 where it will head north. It will then continue on the A4137 to its junction with the A49 .

Road users travelling from the Harewood End Junction requiring access to Wilton Roundabout and the A49 between C and D on the map below will take the A4137 south onto the A40 north-east to Wilton Roundabout to access the A49.
